Jams, Spreads and Vinegars

- i) All jars and bottles to be labelled with product name and class. Label to be no larger than 5cm x 2cm
- ii) All entries to be home made and presented in 200g – 250g jars (net weight)
- iii) Do not seal jars with wax etc.
- iv) All lids to be plain – any advertising must be painted over. No cellophane allowed.
- v) All jars, lids and bottles must be clean and free from mould
- vi) Fill jars and bottles to minimum of 1cm from the top of the jar

336. Painted Tile – Open Section – Adults over 18 years of age.

The tile is to be glazed ceramic or terracotta and no larger than 10cm x 20cm. The painting is to reflect Lavender as its theme.

SCHOOL SECTION

(i) Painted Tiles in School Section to have age of child on back of tile

337. Painted Tile Junior Section – children up to 12 years of age

The tile is to be glazed ceramic or terracotta and no larger than 10cm x 20cm. The painting is to reflect Lavender as its theme.

338. Painted Tile Senior Section – children 13 to 17 years of age

The tile is to be glazed ceramic or terracotta and no larger than 10cm x 20cm. The painting is to reflect Lavender as its theme.
